You will need: Egg box Orange paint Yellow card (or yellow paint) Glue Green drinking straws Sticky tape

Method:

1. Paint the bottom of an egg box, orange and leave to dry, ensuring the paint covers all the surfaces.

2. Draw and cut out, 6 flower shapes from yellow card (or other card painted yellow).

3. Cut the egg box into the individual compartments. Take one compartment and glue to the centre of the flower shape, as the trumpet.

4. Tape a green straw to the back of each daffodil and you are ready to display!
