PRICE WILL BE £3 FOR THE FIRST CHILD AND £1 FOR EACH ADDITIONAL CHILD. THE GROUP IS FOR CHILDREN AGED 5 YEARS AND UNDER, HOWEVER DURING THE HOLIDAYS, OLDER SIBLINGS AGED UP TO 8 YEARS OF AGE ARE WELCOME ALSO.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

WHILST RESTRICTIONS HAVE BEEN LIFTED, WE WOULD STILL "ENCOURAGE" EVERYONE TO REMAIN CAUTIOUS AND PLEASE LIMIT TO 1 ADULT PER CHILD/FAMILY WHEREVER POSSIBLE. ALTHOUGH THERE IS NO RESTRICTION ON NUMBER OF PEOPLE, WE WILL CLOSELY MONITOR NUMBERS IN ATTENDANCE ON ANY ONE DAY AND IF WE FEEL IT IS POSING A RISK WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO CLOSE THE DOORS (OR GARDEN GATE) TO MORE PEOPLE JOINING THE GROUP. WE WILL ALSO ACTIVELY ENCOURAGE ALL ADULTS TO WEAR FACE COVERINGS WHILST INSIDE AND REGULARLY SANITISE THEIR HANDS USING THE SANITISER PROVIDED. TEA AND COFFEE WILL BE AVAILABLE AND FRUIT FOR THE CHILDREN (UNCUT APPLES, ORANGES, PEARS, BANANAS AND RAISIN BOXES). BUGGIES AND PRAMS WILL BE REQUIRED TO BE LEFT OUTSIDE AT THIS TIME.
