MONTHLY REPORT MAY 2024

FULL COUNCIL

The Full Council meeting on Thursday 18 April was cancelled—ostensibly because of lack of business, but in fact because of the two Ely West by-elections on that day.

One of the by-elections in Ely West was for a seat on East Cambridgeshire District Council. The by-election followed a Liberal Democrat resignation (through change of work circumstances) and was won by the Liberal Democrat candidate Ross Trent. The political composition of the district council therefore remains unchanged at 15 Conservatives and 13 Liberal Democrats. The other election was for a seat on City of Ely Council.

PLANNING APPLICATIONS

121-123 High Street Sutton

A reconsultation is taking place following the submission of amendments to the planning application to build nine dwellings on land at 121-123 High Street Sutton and demolish the two existing properties.

Camp's Field Wilburton

The controversial planning application at Camps Field Wilburton has been 'finally disposed of' by the District Council's planning department. The applicant failed to provide information requested by the planning case officer within the time agreed, so the planning application has effectively been deleted.
