## FUN ACTIVITIES TO TRY AT HOME Microwave Mug Cake

#### What you need

- 4tbsp Self raising flower
- 4tbsp Caster sugar
- 2tbsp cocoa powder/ hot chocolate
- 1 medium egg
- 3tbsp milk
- 3tbsp oil
- 2tbsp chocolate chips/ nuts/colouring (optional)
- Toppings (optional)

#### Instructions

- Mix the self-raising flour, caster sugar and cocoa powder into the largest mug you have.
- Add the egg and mix up.
- Add the milk and oil and mix smooth before you add the optional chocolate chips/ nuts.
- Place in centre of microwave and cook for 1.5-2 minutes.
- Add any toppings such a whipped cream and sprinkles
